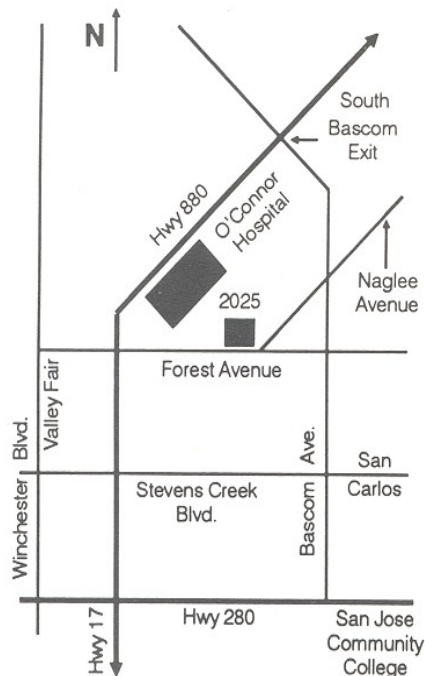
Directions to the San Jose Office:

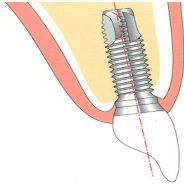

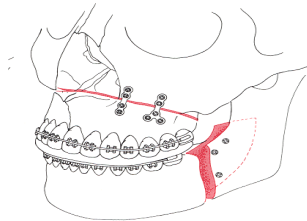

Anesthesia: A major component of Dr. Bohannan's practice is concerned with pain and anxiety control for patients. Out-patient intra-venous (IV) sedation and general anesthesia are services available to reduce apprehension, anxiety and fear. Dr. Bohannan and his staff regularly complete courses in Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), out-patient anesthesia, and management of medical emergencies. Dr. Bohannan's staff and the facility adhere to the standards and regulations required by the California Dental Practice Act.

Professional Biography and Practice

Dr. William Bruce Bohannan is a Bay Area native, born and raised in San Mateo. After finishing Serra High School, he attended U.C. Davis where he received his bachelor of science in physiology. He then attended University of the Pacific in San Francisco and graduated with high honors, earning membership in OKU and TKO honor societies, as well as an award from the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, for "Excellence and Aptitude in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery". In 1992, he began his oral surgery residency and attended the University of Missouri School of Medicine where he graduated with high honors and received the Award for Meritorious Performance in Physical Diagnosis from the American College of Physicians. He completed an internship, general surgery and his Oral and Maxillofacial surgery training at Truman Medical Center in Kansas City, Missouri. While a resident, Dr. Bohannan was elected Surgical Resident of the Year of Truman Medical Center for two years in a row. Dr. Bohannan was appointed an Associate Professor of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery after he graduated.

After completion of his residency in 1997, Dr. Bohannan moved back to the Bay Area where he has remained ever since. Dr. Bohannan practices a full scope of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery.
